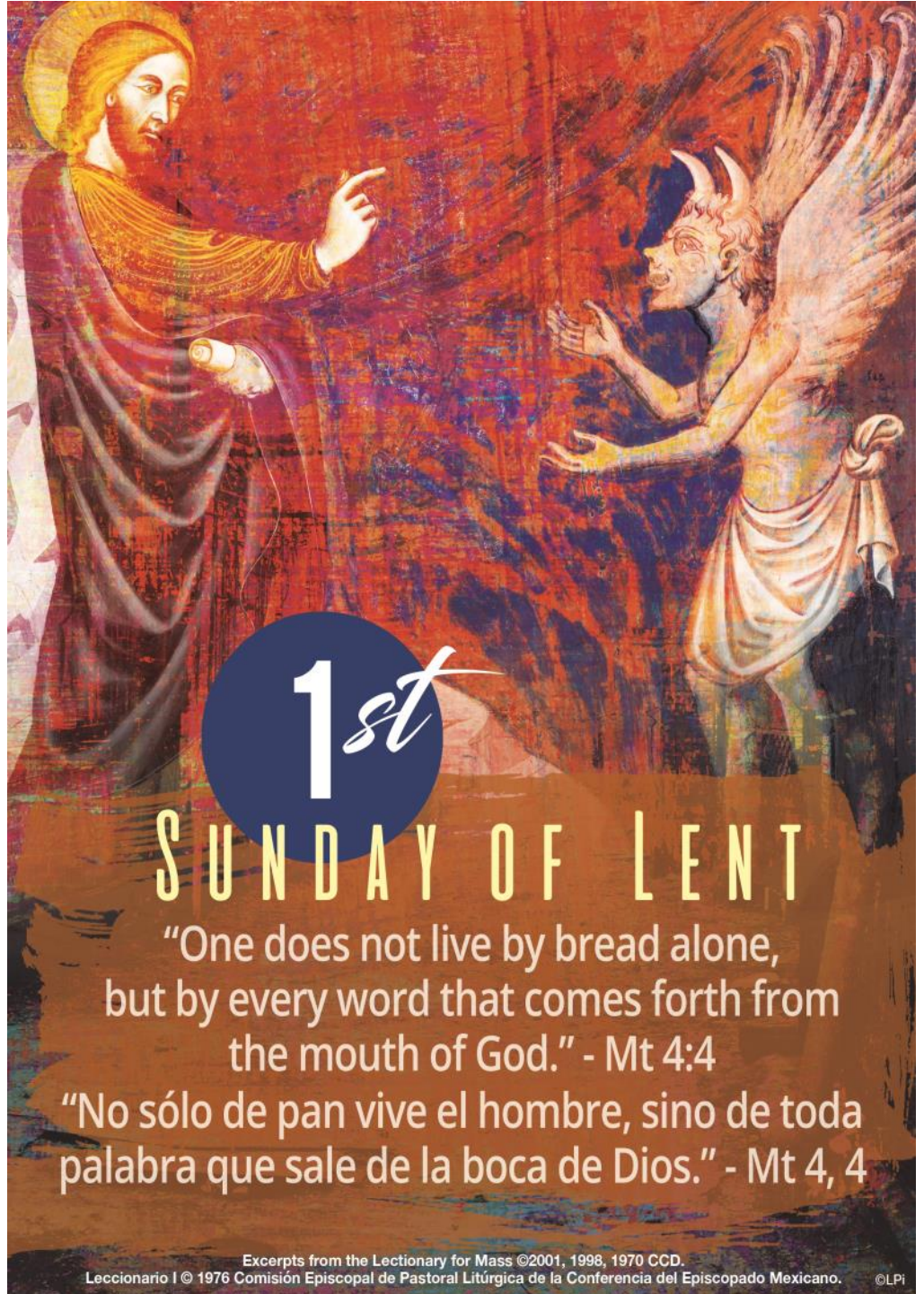

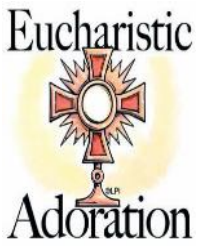

Anyone who has received their First Communion can be an altar server.

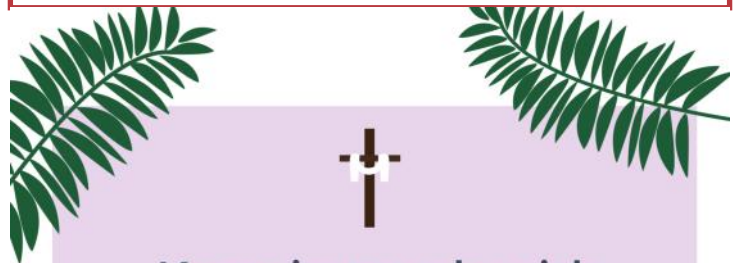
