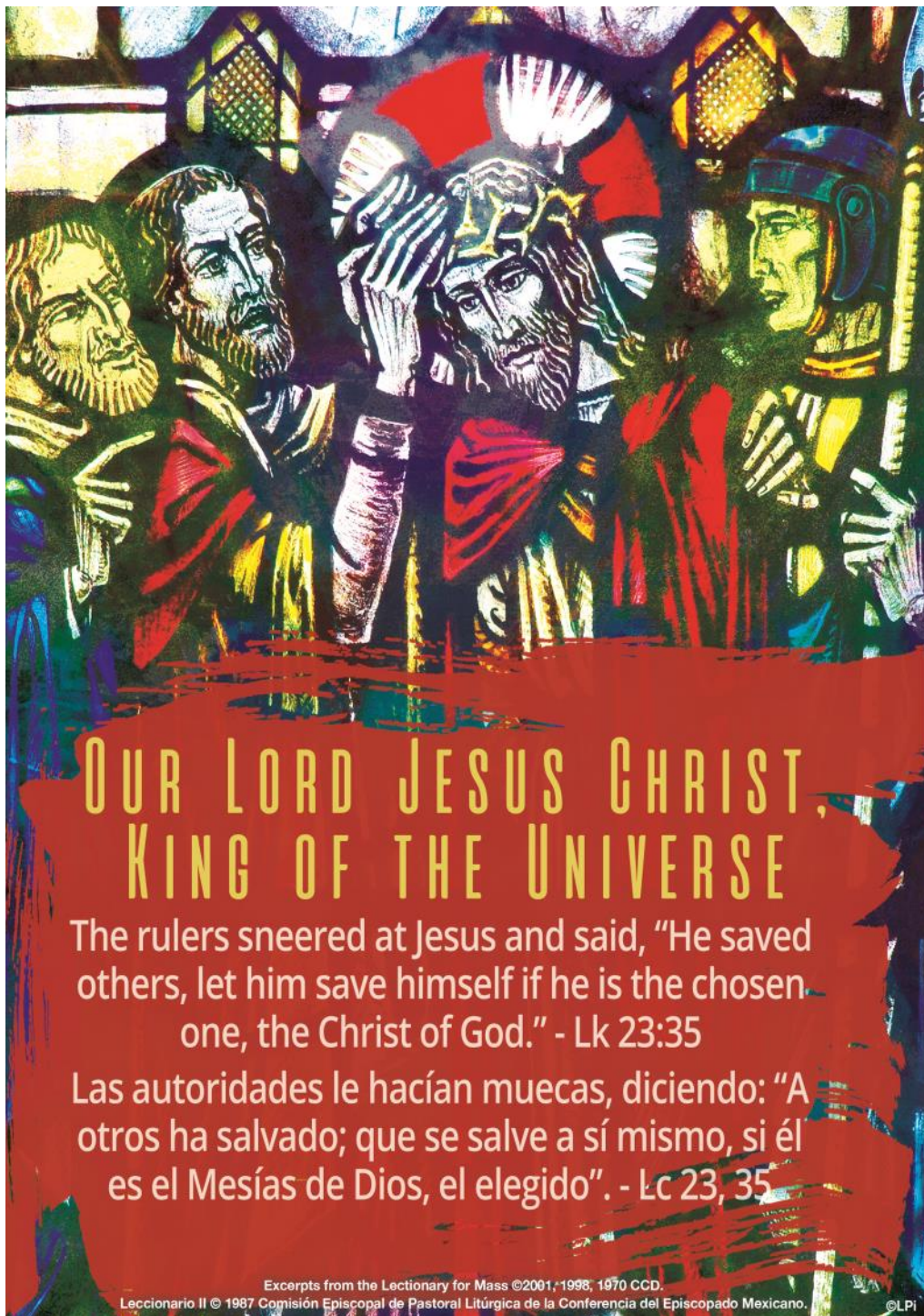

The plan is made up of 4 pillars; **Eucharist and Catholic Identity/Unity in Diversity**; **Faith Formation**; **Evangelization/Hospitality**; and **Stewardship**. Within each pillar are Goals, Objectives, and Strategies. We hope that our plan will provide all of us with a clear understanding of the future of our parish.

The Charting Our Course steering committee has been meeting regularly for the past several weeks and we are close to finalizing the final document. The final plan will be published and made available to every parishioner as well as online.
