We have a confirmed Covid-19 case in our parish. Unfortunately, Father Javier and the parish staff are now considered to be exposed and have begun their isolation.

To ensure the safety of our parishioners, Father Javier, both Deacons and the entire staff will be tested for Covid-19.

Out of an abundance of caution we are taking the following steps.

Until Further Notice:

- Daily and weekend Masses are cancelled. (October 10th & 11th).
- The Church Building and Parish office will be closed.
- All CCD and RCIA classes are postponed.
- There will be no Confessions nor Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament .
- The Church and office will be thoroughly cleaned by a certified in Covid-19 disinfection.

Finally, once we received the results of the COVID-19 tests we will provide a status update through: Flocknote, Parish Website, Facebook Page.

Se ha dado un caso de Covid-19 en nuestra parroquia. Desafortunadamente, el Padre Javier y el equipo parroquial estuvieron en contacto directo con esta persona. Como resultado, el Padre Javier y todo el personal ya empezaron su aislamiento. Para garantizar la seguridad de nuestros feligreses, el Padre, los diáconos, y todo el equipo parroquial se someterá a las pruebas médicas del Covid-19.

Hemos tomado varias medidas de precaución entre las cuales se incluyen las siguientes:

- Las misas diarias y de fin de semana se cancelan hasta nuevo aviso. (Sábado 10 de Octubre y Domingo 11 de Octubre).
- La Iglesia y las oficinas permanecerán cerradas.
- Todas las clases de CCD (Catecismo) y RCIA (Formación de Adultos) se posponen hasta nuevo aviso.
- No habrá Confesiones ni Adoración del Santísimo Sacramento.
- La Iglesia, la Capilla, y las oficinas serán completamente desinfectadas por una compañía profesional que está debidamente acreditada para desinfectar y limpiar los edificios afectados por el COVID-19.

For \$20 you can buy a coat for a homeless or refugee child. The lack of a coat is the #1 reason kids stay home from school in the winter. This is as much an education program as it is a health program. The Knights buy the coats in bulk (over 100,000 last year) to get the best pricing. Many of the coats come with suggested MSRP of more than \$100/each.
