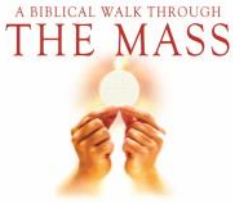

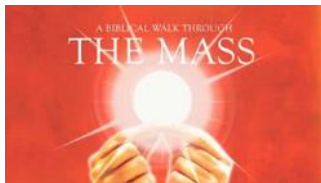

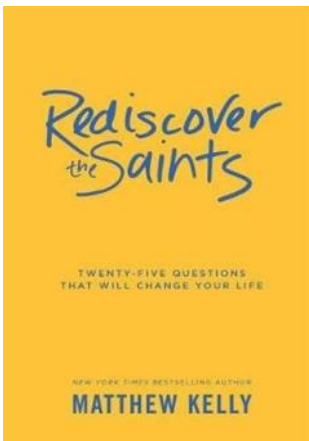

DAY OF PRAYER FOR THE LEGAL PROTECTION OF UNBORN CHILDREN

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court legalized abortion throughout the United States in its companion decisions *Roe v. Wade* and *Doe v. Bolton*. Since that time, millions of children have lost their lives and millions of women and families have been wounded by abortion.

The Catholic bishops of the United States have designated January 22, 2020 as a particular day of prayer and penance, called the **"Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children."** This day shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.
