The Profession of Faith (Nicene Creed)

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. Baptism: You must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months. Register your child in the parish office before attending the class, bring birth certificate and \$50 donation.

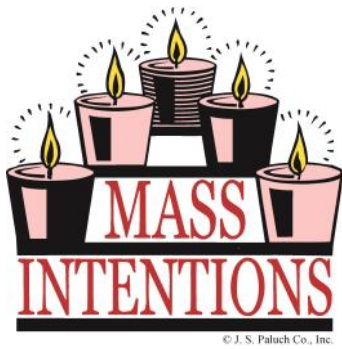
