



St. Joseph the Worker church is a place of peace where parishioners go for prayer, spiritual growth and community. We are blessed to have such a beautiful sanctuary for our worship. However, we also have to consider practical concerns for our

church; things like safety and security, lighting and protection of its property. These are matters for which any public space must plan. In so doing, we can protect our church property from theft, vandalism, or worse.

For some time now, we have witnessed recurring instances when our church property has had unauthorized late night and weekend entries into our property. Thus, as pastor, with advice from my staff, and Parish Council, we have decided to install security gates at both the Redwood Road and Bora Bora Drive entrances. These gates will inject needed security for our parish home and better help control the weekly flow of traffic into our parking areas. We expect to have the new gates installed in February and will keep everyone apprised of the progress.

Upon installation the gates will function as follows:

1. The Redwood Road west gate will be closed M-F. **Traffic will enter/exit from Bora Bora Drive.**
2. The Redwood Road west gate will be opened on weekends for regular church services.
3. The Redwood Road west gate will be opened on weekdays as church activities require.
4. **The Bora Bora Drive north gate will become the weekday Main Entrance/Exit to the church.**
5. The Bora Bora Drive north gate will be open M-F and weekends for Mass and associated church activities.

Each year on January 22, all dioceses in the United States are called to observe a Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children. January 22 is the anniversary of the 1973 Supreme Court decisions that legalized abortion throughout our nation. Individually, we are called to observe this day through the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and/or giving alms for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and through penance for all violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. Let us offer our prayer and penance that all human life would be welcomed in love and protected in law.
