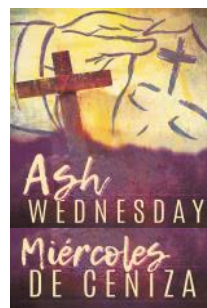

PRAYING 40 DAYS FOR LIFE

40 Days for Life is the largest internationally coordinated Pro-Life campaign to end abortion. Twice a year, communities throughout the world join together praying peacefully to witness to the dignity of all human life, especially the unborn.

The 40 Days for Life Spring vigil begins on Wednesday, February 26th and ends on Sunday, March 5th. If you feel that you don't know what you, individually, can do to help end abortion, know that we can all pray. Please join our St. Joseph the Worker parish family as we pray continuously during this vigil.

We have a 40 Days for Life book in the Gathering Space where you can sign up for one or more hours to pray during this vigil.
